When an Error is Displayed Regarding Automatic Duplex Printing Cause The correct media size is not selected in the printer driver. Error No. 300 is Displayed Cause The machine is not ready. Machine is not properly connected. Troubleshooting Action Uninstall then reinstall the MP Drivers. Once the waste ink absorber becomes completely full, printing cannot be done until the waste ink absorber is replaced. Canon recommends to contact the Canon Customer Care Center as soon as possible. Canon support staff are trained to be able to provide technical support to satisfy customers. Attempts by customers to repair or take apart the machine will invalidate any Caution warranty regardless of whether the warranty has expired.
