Accreditation is an indication that high quality services are provided. The result of an accreditation survey. The outcome is determined by CARF based on the findings of the CARF surveyors who conduct onsite reviews. There are five possible accreditation decisions ThreeYear accreditation; OneYear accreditation; Provisional Accreditation; Nonaccreditation; and Preliminary Accreditation. 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This is not a term used by CARF. See the definitions for the terms Survey, ReSurvey, and Original Survey. Established in 1966, CARF International is an independent, nonprofit accreditor of health and human services providers. Conformance to standards is assessed during onsite reviews by CARF surveyors who are peer reviewers i.e., currently employed in a CARF accredited organization. An objective, methodical management system of identifying areas for improvement and continually increase quality of work processes. CQI involves the use of statistical tools to identify problems. Specific expectations for improvement and the means to measure them are established. Implementation of identified changes are directed towards preventing future problems in these areas and involves the setting of goals, education of staff, and measurement of results which are shared with stakeholders. Empowerment of employees is a critical part of this process. Because of their exposure to and relationship with numerous organizations, consultants are aware of industry

“best practices.” For example, the independent accreditation consultant may receive payment only if the organization achieves a ThreeYear CARF accreditation if this was the outcome desired by the organization. If the goal is not achieved, the consultant is not paid. In other words, individuals with substance use conditions often have a mental health condition at the same time and vice versa. The term cooccurring is becoming the more commonly used term in behavioral health and is synonymous with dual diagnosis. The consultant first determines the baseline cost of the service, then adds a proportion as a markup e.g., 20% which results in the total cost to the customer. This fee schedule provides the consultant with his or her desired profit margin. The purpose of costplus pricing is for the consultant to maximize his or her profits. There may be a minimum number of days required e.g., a twoday minimum. An expert who is employed externally by the organization and whose expertise is provided on a temporary basis, usually for a fee. This type of consultant usually contracts with multiple clients concurrently. All customers receive the same price for the same service. Various components of these confidentiality guidelines require national standards for electronic health care transactions as well as provisions for the security and privacy of health data i.e., Protected Health Information; PHI . When providing consulting services, it is the practice of Behavioral Health Resources to use, publish, and distribute CARFrelated documents and materials that are in the public domain e.g., available on the CARF website. Within 90 days after receiving notification of an accreditation decision, a CARF accredited organization is required to submit a written report i.e., the QIP describing the actions that have been or will be taken to correct areas where recommendations were given in the Survey Report. For organizations receiving a OneYear or Provisional Accreditation decision, the QIP is submitted to CARF within 45 days. A systematic review of records of the persons served. CARF requires that a representative sample of open and closed records be reviewed. Although CARF does not indicate what percentage is a representative sample, CARF surveyors often determine this to be at about 10%. The fee is paid when the Consulting Agreement is signed and before services are provided. Discounts can be applied for longterm contracts. Here is what providers can expect when seeking accreditation by CARF International. Besides addiction treatment and behavioral health facilities, CARF also accredits providers related to aging services, child and youth services, and durable medical equipment. The first step is to obtain a copy of CARF's most recent standards manual.

These manuals are updated each year. They should then submit a survey application to CARF with details about their services and facilities. The provider is then charged a CARF survey fee. This survey team examines the applicant, observes its services, interviews patients, and reviews documentation. In addition, the survey team offers consultation to facility staff. CARF usually sends its decision within 68 weeks of completing the survey, along with a report and Quality Improvement Plan QIP. If the provider received accreditation, it must also submit a signed Annual Conformance to Quality Report each year. The survey is an ideal way for providers to learn how to improve their services and facilities. This includes continued education opportunities, such as the CARF Surveyor Continuing Education Conference and Winter Transforming Outcomes Institute. Earlier this year, CARF hosted an International Standards Advisory Committee ISAC to discuss possible updates to technology standards in CARF's ASPIRE to Excellence framework. At another meeting, an ISAC began work on new standards for Medication Assisted Treatment Programs. To learn more about

This certification holds RISE to rigorous standards set forth by the Department of Human Services Division of Mental Health in order to ensure persons served are receiving quality treatment. Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities CARF International RISE Behavioral Health and Wellness demonstrates current accreditation status through the Standards Manual and Interpretive Guidelines for Behavioral Health as released by CARF International. RISE has been accredited with CARF International since 1997 and has received three-year accreditations since first becoming an accredited agency.

CARF International is a private, nonprofit organization that provides accreditation surveys, workshops, and conferences, in effort to promote quality and optimal outcomes of services for behavioral health programs. CARF International releases a Behavioral Health Standards Manual annually, to which RISE policies, procedures, and practices must comply, in order to ensure all persons served are receiving effective treatment. The Standards Manual and Interpretive Guidelines for Behavioral Health includes standards related to leadership, financial planning and management, health and safety, human resources, technology, rights of persons served, performance management and measurement, as well as standards specifically related to every service provided by the agency. These standards are incorporated into RISE's policies and procedures and are reviewed annually, per CARF standards, to ensure compliance. Once new policies and procedures are approved, they are immediately implemented to ensure upmost compliance with incorporating and implementing new standards. The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, shortened to CARF, is an independent, nonprofit organization that aims to improve the quality of services for rehabilitative care. It covers a variety of environments, including disability rehabilitation, addiction and substance abuse treatment, retirement living and more. CARF has a broad reach across the world, including Oceania and branches in Canada and Europe. Their accreditation process is comprehensive, and receiving it provides a trusted seal of approval to a behavioral and mental health practice. When CARF accredits an organization, it informs the public that this facility reaches high standards of health, safety, respect and quality of care. Accreditation creates a standard for facilities to aim toward.

It helps make healthcare more consistent and increase the safety and trust in rehabilitation facilities. Many of these facilities are privately owned and do not require any licensing. This lack of an official status can hurt the reputation of established, research-based practices. It can also reduce the high standard most healthcare organizations strive to achieve. By receiving the CARF seal, an organization proves that it adheres to CARF's commitment to quality service. Population designations such as autism spectrum disorder, criminal justice and eating disorders can also apply to a program. Preparation involves creating documentation that identifies vital information about the providers vision, mission and statements, as well as its programs, services, leadership and locations. CARF must receive the application at least three months before the requested survey date. After purchasing a standards manual, which gets updated yearly, the provider can begin the process of receiving accreditation with the help of a CARF resource specialist. The provider can receive a three-year accreditation, a one-year accreditation, a provisional accreditation or nonaccreditation. CARF also sends a Quality Improvement Plan QIP, which addresses areas of improvement identified in the survey. This process includes submitting their QIP and an Annual Conformance to Quality Report. CARF stays in touch with the provider during the accreditation tenure, and providers can contact CARF as needed if they require help to maintain conformance. All aim to uphold the core values and commitments of CARF. These standards ensure your patients are safe and treated with respect. They should be well-informed of their rights and medical care, and policies need to be readily available. Patients must be free from adverse events such as abuse, exploitation or humiliation. Including documentation and plans to address your patients rights can help you ace this standard.

You should develop a plan for components such as hardware, software, backup policies, security and confidentiality. Make sure you have well-documented emergency procedures, develop transportation safety standards and perform emergency drills regularly. CARF promotes continuing education and training events so providers can stay up to date and maintain their accreditation status. This person can answer questions and direct you to relevant resources as you prepare for your survey. Survey preparation workbooks are also available for purchase from CARF. CARF consultants can help you with the process, as these people are specially trained to reach accreditation. The Joint Commission JCAHO is another accreditation organization. It is an American nonprofit that covers a broad range of healthcare services. Your EHR is an essential component of how you do business.
